At the June workshop we will also help you get the trees in tip top shape. You can be doing weeding now and cleaning pots and polishing stands. We can always use accent plants if you are so inclined.

Make sure you mark out time to spend being a docent at our exhibit during the 5 day course of the Fair. It runs from June 30 - July 4 and there are 3 shifts each day. We need for all of them to be

fully staffed so we can make sure our trees are safe from curious fingers, well watered, and the public well informed about the glorious art of bonsai. There will be sign up lists at the June workshop and meeting, so check your calendars, confer with significant others, look at the Fair schedule for other events you might want to explore on the same day, and sign up for at least 2 shifts, or more if you can possibly manage it. We need all hands on deck at the Fair, and for set up and take down as well.

The Fair exhibit is a fund raiser for the Club and one of our best opportunities to reach out to the public and recruit new members. It's easy. It's fun. Your Club really needs you to help out.

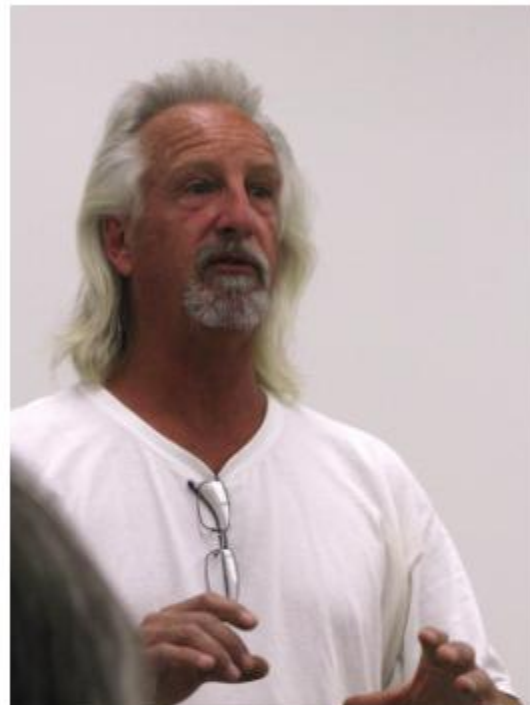
