WIRING FUNDAMENTALS



(Susan) Here are the benefits of taking payments by Square: More people will pay and pay early. I'm suggesting an increase in membership fees for singles to \$50 and family to \$70. Keep Student fee the same. After square's fees (2.9% +30 cents per transaction) that gives us: Single \$50 is \$3.25 more per year. Family \$70 is \$7.67 more per year.
